

BIRDWATCH LIST OF BIRDS THAT FREQUENT THE GOLFCOURSE AREA

This list is ADDITIONAL to the list found in The Fallbrook Pocket Field Guide. At least 50 of the birds in the Field guide can be found on the golf course. This is a huge migratory corridor for a great variety of birds. Many of the birds seen on the ponds winter here. The drought has affected migration patterns and I am seeing birds not seen before, and NOT seeing birds that used to come through routinely.
